<u>Guest Speaker:</u> Michelle Heath plus students—Cambodia Visit

- Coordinates student visits to Cambodia each year which have a focus on community, compassion, challenges and courage
- Five trips in five years
- About 16 students each year travel with 4 teachers for 2 weeks
- Students pay their airfare and accommodation and commit to fundraise at least \$1000 of the \$3200 overall cost per person
- Students fundraise through selling donuts, garage sales, raffles, selling chocolates, sausage sizzles, movie nights
- The trip offers opportunity to understand the history of Cambodia
- Highlights include: seeing how friendly and happy the locals were, farm night stays and viewing the night sky without light pollution, visiting the Sight for Life eye clinic,
- Group learn to be travellers and just not tourists
- Engagement with the locals encouraged
- Experience examples of social enterprise, micro finance and the Toot Toot business
- Emphasis that children are not tourist attractions
- An opportunity to help others
- 2h project which is a focus on the importance of the arts
- MAG which is an organisation working in Cambodia for over 25 years dedicated to clearing minefields and cluster munitions contaminated areas and helping communities stay safe
- Met survivors of the Pol Pot regime
- Trip provided new perspective on how to deal with people and world problems
