Guest Speaker: District Governor John Pohl

- Intro in District Director
- Most concerning issue declining membership lost 63 last year part of a downward trend over recent years
- Holding a series of meetings on this topic
- Challenge for our club to write a membership plan to receive \$200 + \$200 grants
- John Hendrickson first important factor in membership is pivotal decision to attend second meeting because first meeting welcoming and informative - level of comfort important. Second aspect is branding eg Facebook and website
- Master brand is Rotary wheel. Our club can create own brand by adding club name to Rotary Wheel which is the mark of excellent. The wheel may be used for special events but club does not own the brand
- Rotary Foundation Centenary next year. Goal is to raise \$1500 per club to polio plus and \$ to Foundation. Bill and Melinda Gates still donating \$2 for every dollar raised
- Youth programmes thank you for this club's support for youth programmes
- Council on Legislation: Clubs can determine how often and when they meet providing at least twice a month. Also can determine attendance requirements. Classification requirements changed
- Child protection requirements reminder if involved in community projects or events you must have police check.
- Social media up to date
- Crisis Management Policy needs to be followed.
- Never say to reporter "no comment" Say I am not authorised to comment on this matter. Please speak to (higher) authority

- Rotary is not the fundraising arm for everyone who requests help.
- Vocational Training: VTT will no longer be funded by district.
