Australia Day

January 26 commemorates the day the commander of the First Fleet, Captain Arthur Phillip, rowed ashore at Sydney Cove, raised the Union Jack and proclaimed British sovereignty over part of the continent in 1788.

One of the biggest early celebrations was in 1818 when Governor Lachlan Macquarie hosted a 30-gun salute to celebrate its 30th anniversary. Later annual regattas on Sydney Harbour became a popular attraction.

By 1888, "Anniversary Day" as it was then known, was a holiday in all capital cities except Adelaide.

It wasn't until 1935 that all states adopted a common date and name for Australia Day to be held on January 26.
