- Chairman of local National Trust.
- Local museum 59 Murray St
- Established under act of parliament to ensure assets protected and people have access
- Cultural tourism taking off in Australia. 30% of people have interest in heritage buildings
- Museums a cemetery of brickabrack but people want the stories and to participate in the stories if possible
- Trails of experiences are current trend
- Aim to co-operate between states
- Small committee discussing what museum should be to be relevant
- Many museums stuck in 19th century concepts
- Need cultural centre telling local history with modern storytelling and touchable artefacts.
- Cutting edge technology needed for next generation
- Building needs to be architecturally acceptable, comfortable and motivate people to revisit
- Stories. Thomas Dundas Murray who came to Gawler with family in late 1830s
- Dead Man's Pass, 1837.
- Good news; Gawler selected to lead change with huge upgrade. Funding not yet.
- Looking at Federal funds to rebuild interior.
- Need letters to National Trust, from members of community in support of funding
