David Weatherley

Since August 2010 David has served in a number of roles, most notably as Club President in 2016/2017 and more recently as the Youth Services Director.

David has been instrumental in forging Rotary's relationship with the Town of Gawler, including liaising with Councillors and administration to assist and further Rotary causes, particularly in the area of Youth. The current reputation our club has with the Town of Gawler is in large part due to David's ongoing diligent work with all key parties.

David is also a Board member of the Gawler & District College Foundation, working with the school community. A major outcome of David's involvement has been to help facilitate a scholarship program through generous external donors for the purposes of promoting Rotary International Youth Exchange.

David's list of community achievements includes the establishment of the Wheels in Motion Gawler program in mid 2018. The program assists youth who through financial or other circumstances may find themselves without the means to obtain the required driving hours to obtain their Ps.

David applied for funding from the South Australian State Government under the "Fund My Neighbourhood" program to purchase a vehicle and provide the necessary funding for initial 12 months of operation. All aspects of the program have been managed by David since inception.

This program has already seen 8 young people succeed in getting their Ps, with many more approaching completion.
