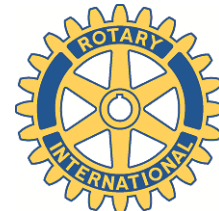

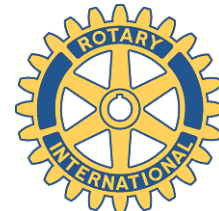

Guest Speaker: Peter Thomas

- Rotarians against Malaria
- History project to commemorate 50 years of Rotary. Grant from Rotary Foundation
- Peter managed setting up on Solomon Islands but went to Bougainville because of unsafe conditions in Solomon's
- Built houses for project workers in 9 provinces of Solomon's
- Many mosquito nets taken to the area
- Increasing awareness led to establishing UN Global Funding
- Australian Govt started to fund construction costs and Rotary focused mainly on infrastructure
- Disabling illness that has adverse effect on whole community
- Ron Sedden now runs as business employing people doing main component of Mosquito netting work
- Now other foundations involved
- Difficult in Timor Leste. No money
- Also involved in working against TB and HIV Aides
- TB in Papua New Guinea now drug resistant
- Peter is now last of original committee and is concerned about the direction change
- Allegations about misuse of funds being investigated. This has effected the availability of Global Funds and tightening of accountability procedures
- Papua New Guinea going well being run by Rotarians. Timor Leste need help with funding issues. Vanuatu operation has collapsed partially because of natural disasters.
- TB on the increase and resistant to drugs. New wormwood based medication for malaria which is effective at present
- 1.3 million people die with malaria every year
