Guest Speaker: Bron Anderson, Super Changes

- General information only, no personal advice
- Been in financial services for close to 2 decades and has seen many changes to superannuation and retirement planning
- Lots happening this year
- After tax contributions reduced to \$100k per year (\$300k under bring forward rule)
- Certain eligibility required to meet bring forward rule
- No contributions if super balance is \$1.6M +
- Before tax contributions reduced to \$25k per year, regardless of age
- Employer contributions included in \$25k limit
- Contributions to constitutionally protected funds will count towards limit but not on their own
- Additional 15% tax on certain concessional contributions if your adjusted income is over \$250k
- Spouse contribution tax offset—up to \$540 available
- Spouse income threshold increased to \$37,000 from \$10,800, phased out at \$40,000 (prev \$13,800)
- Low income super tax offset available for individuals with adjusted income up to \$37,000
- Tax deductions on personal contributions available to people under 65 or those who meet work test up to age 74
- Can carry forward unused before tax contributions from 1 July 2018 over 5 years
- Transition to retirement pensions—15% tax on earnings
- Super balance transfer cap of \$1.6M
- Anti detriment payments no longer available
- Changes mean opportunities, danger for others
- Seek personal advice from an appropriately licensed professional
