District Governor: David Egan

- In 1991 there were 1900 members in the Group with an average age of 67
- In 2018 there are 989 members with an average age of 67
- 1.7% of current members are under 40
- Net 180 members have left over the last 3 years
- Need to support change management
- Provide challenge for young leaders
- Instead of doing the same consider innovating this year
- Be the inspiration
- Focus on leadership and not management
- Last thing you need is conflict in a Club
- Need to value our senior members
- Need for positive change

Guest Speaker: Ron Kandelaars

- Worked in the media for nearly forty years. Over the past four decades, he's gone on to become a Chief of Staff, State Political Reporter and TV Producer.
- For thirteen years he was a presenter and producer of the award-winning travel and lifestyle program Postcards on the Nine Network.
- In 2011, Ron was awarded South Australian of the Year (Tourism) in the Advantage SA South Australian of the Year Awards; and Outstanding Contribution by an Individual in the South Australian Tourism Awards.
- Ron is a freelance journalist who regularly travels
 Australia in search of longer magazine-style stories for Channel Seven News
- Postcards had a small budget
- Did 15 stories in a 5 day period focusing on areas like the Clare Valley, Lake Eyre
- After a few weeks would produce each show with stories from different regions
- Combined multiple sources of vision from for example a helicopter, or from a boat with music from his mother's ABC collections
- One story focussed on Nuriootpa and a caravan on the back of a truck made in 1931 by Gerhard Kaesler
- It was all about accessing the right people and mixing with a variety of shots and locations
- Spoke about the making of sausages and the Butcher glass (about 200ml) which was introduced in an effort to reduce the amount of drinking on the job
- Now working for Channel 7 doing similar stories as Postcards
- The plethora of TV stations including Netflix spelt the demise of Postcards
- Now also conducts media training for people
- A good interview should look like a conversation
- Need to prepare responses
- When on a good thing repeat it
- Speak in visual language eg Keating's quote of a soufflé cannot rise twice
