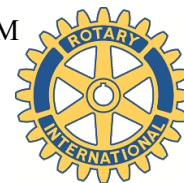

- SA well endowed with nat resources eg gas
- Map of exploration licences and applications shown and explained
- 1866 first oil in SA. Used for lamps, lubrication etc
- Exploration and production
- Seismic lines - Sound waves used detect structure under ground – seismic surveys
- Trucks approx 30 tonnes
- 3 or 4 trucks in a row
- Part of Dave's role to minimise footprint of seismic trucks
- Water drill bit shown – petroleum drill bit is larger
- Photos of Cooper Basin, Moomba
- Offshore larger scale - Offshore work part of role
- SA Producing oil since 1968 down SE
- Also promotes investment in state and role as regulator
- Fracking
- Balancing community expectations, legislation and interests of all stakeholders as well as protecting environment
- Management of approval process
- Seismic line rehab
- Cooper Basin world class for conventional and unconventional
- Offshore oil rig photos
- Expect \$200million per rig
- Unconventional gas issues also risk assessed and managed. Need to address misconceptions
- Onshore deposits tend to be smaller in size which makes offshore attractive
