Guest Speaker: Bianca (Paramedic)

- Grew up in Gawler
- Went to Flinders Uni to study to be paramedic; 3 year degree
- Cardiac arrest, respiratory, drug, trauma, mental health, health science
- Research project on effects of cancer on children
- Had thoughts about doing nursing
- Did work experience with intensive care para medic as mentor for a year
- Applied to do post grad degree in nursing for 4 weeks but decided not to continue and applied for internship
- 30 positions although 200+ graduates.

- Internship 13 months; now in 11th month
- Started with training: clinical and on-road
- Started Redwood Park, then Playford and now Salisbury
- Ambulance driver training 3 weeks. Sometimes now drives ambulance
- Between studies travelled to Cambodia and Vietnam with friends. Did volunteer work in orphanage for disabled children
- Saw things that we wouldn't accept here.
- Paramedic skills were very useful
- Spent 5 weeks in Europe around 12 months ago
- Ambulances are top heavy and can roll so not wise to go too fast
- Most stations have pagers, some have bell
- Jobs prioritised and this impacts on response time depending on who is available and if busy
- Handover to nursing staff at hospital 15 minutes 15 minutes paperwork
- Night shift as busy as day shift. 12 hour shifts, 4 days on (2 day/2 night) and 4 off
- Sometimes follows up on patients to see outcome.
- Counselling offered after serious jobs in various ways.
 Need to depersonalise things and put them aside.
 Plenty sources of support offered and available when wanted
