- Tractor Pulls
- Visit from Peter Thomas regarding RAMs Project
- Backing by Bill Gates
- Needed to put small warehouses on Solomon Islands
- Designed here and constructed about a dozen on various islands.
- Needed to build two small houses for medical staff. 14 or 15 build in various locations.
- While there bob and his group slept in local small huts
- Saw much timber being cut but locals not being adequately compensated by organisations who came in took what they wanted
- Developed project to enable locals to cut and sell timber themselves so that they could be a self sustainable community.
- Applied for grant to build movable timber mill. Cost to be repaid over 3 years and this could then be used to replicate the project in other communities
- Tractor Pull helped to raise funds for to saw mill. Donations made by group 9 clubs.
- When the mill arrived a duty was deamed payable before it could leave the port. Negotiations to be exempt left \$5000 still payable.
- 3 cubic metres per day can be cut ie 9 cubic metres per week.
- Repayment stopped in 2014 and there is still \$13000 owing. Need to be investigated with a view to solving the problem and recover costs
- Solomons has changed since first visit
- Guest speaker 2: Eric Filmer
- Invited by Bob to go with him to the Solomons
- Had the task of getting machine off wharf and dealing with import tax
- Transported mill to intended island using small boat
- Bill Gates funded mosquito nets
