- Largest fire in area since 1996
- Maps of are burnt

- 1700 personnel I response
- 2 deaths, 97 homes destroyed besides crops, animals and other property
- Pinery Fire Recovery Structure includes committees planning for next possible event to improve response and prevention strategies as well as measures to address needs of communities in recovering.

- Suicide prevention
- Mental health awareness
