- Challenge for young female teacher to teach them science
- 2008 minister's forum
- FLO Flexible Learning Options – keeping kids engaged in school
- 2 regions in the state became pilot sites
- Students needing alternative pathway to several previous attempts to support
- 4th week census when participants need to have been identified
- Wide variety of participants
- Able to participate usually to 21, some 25 to complete SACE
- Could lead to Tafe, apprenticeship, employment etc
- Research by Fuller on baggage of students in poverty, DV, homeless, mental health issues and other difficulties
- Flexible learning space – Gawler House
- First aim to improve literacy and numeracy skills
- Certificate 3 community services students
- ESD -Employability skills development course
- Short trade based courses to sample various fields, resilience and survival skills included
- Each and every student individually catered for
- Continual evaluation and identifying wide variety of opportunities in the school and community
- Currently 86 students involved
- Handing responsibility to students and using their input and feedback
- Empowering kids to move out of problem circumstances
