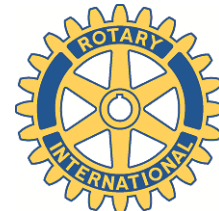

- Prisoners children more likely to go to prison than general population
- Gifts for special occasions
- 2 night camps twice a year
- Salary for executive director and 2 staff raised
- www.secondchances.org.au
- Background in community services and community development
- Started camping programme for children of prisoners 8 years ago
- Strong ratio of adult leaders (1:8) to kids needed
- Firsthand experience of parent in prison and effects of domestic violence
- Ryan's story an example of the success of the programme
- Teen camps for children 12years and older as well as camps for younger students
- All leaders volunteers trained in mandated reporting and Kidsafe
- Adventure camping but emphasis on mentoring and support
- Cost \$1000 per child to run the camps requiring vigorous fundraising
- Leadership weekend for children aged 13 to 19 with leadership potential. Some now camp leaders

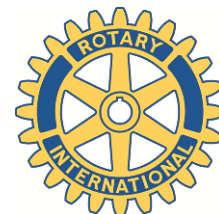

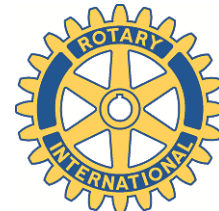
