- Moved from city and chose area near Rosedale
- Bought 15 acres
- Had degree in Ag Science and worked in mining and he had masters in psych and similar
- Moved from city for tree change but realised that lifestyle hadn't changed
- Researched possibilities and decided to try chickens in mobile pens
- Designed and implemented bespoke chicken farming system
- Started small with trial batches and then expanded to supplying local chefs then Farmers' Markets
- Minimised capital purchases
- Needed to ensure able to innovate and change
- Important to be ethical farmers but price was a barrier
- Designed and implemented quail breeding
- Advised by chef customer that quality quail not available locally
- Key challenges scale
- Young twins to care for
- Time
- Cash flow, small scale a disadvantage to achieve price negotiation
- Packaging and labelling –truth in labelling key but competitors using terms differently. Getting the brand right.
- Sourcing expertise

- Difficult to source quails so had to breed own stock


