# <u>Guest Speaker:</u> David Cockshell on RAH Container to Nepal

- 23 projects completed
- Total projects 28 in 21 countries
- Equivalent 41 x 20 foot containers
- Went to Fiji in July last year
- John Price coordinator would be in Nepal and able to make arrangements
- All goods brought up to "as new" condition before packing—requirement to import into Nepal
- Container escorted through India by member of receiving Rotary club
- 29 million people in Nepal
- Only non rectangular flag in world
- Dry and dusty but muddy when rain due to soil type
- Container unpacked and goods loaded into trucks
- Hospital for disabled children only all medical help, food etc founded through non government funds
- Children crossed raging river on rope to get to school. Some drowned. Rotarians built footbridges
- Houses 4 or 5 stories due to shortage of flat land
- Many skilled people work in other countries to support family
- Earthquake in 2015. Make ship repairs and supports for damaged buildings
- Mountain flight delayed twice before getting to site Mt Everest
