- 18 months ago contacted by bank that handles micro loans. Bank wanted someone to manage project.
- Chicken project in Cambodia
- Country now recovering from civil war and execution of many educated people
- Non profit organisation set up by an Aussie.
- Foundation social business to set up people to be able to help themselves
- Set up chicken operation "Dana Asia"
- Transparency key to getting bank onside
- Set up in other countries listed quickly
- Now operating for 2 1/2 years
- Wanted to set up project to feed community and free girls from salvaging from tip to sell and survive.
- Objective to improve stability, best practice, robust system, research local chickens (diseases etc) work with farm management to improve and serve as model for other places
- Schooling requires uniform which is often shared with siblings
- Village women and children make living on rubbish dump
- Young and mature women rescued from waste tip
- Farm staff training. Built training facility, hatchery etc
- 20acres
- Biosecurity very important to manage risk of disease
- Khmer chicken farm originally had thatched roof but now replaced with iron
- Chickens have very slow growth because of poor food so better quality feed accessed.
- Importing new genetic stock to improve quality of meat
- Free range site for breeding hens
- Introduced measures for biosecurity.
- Want to set up low cost meat chicken farms
- Bank not yet funding but will when assured that success assured
- Only training and employing women.
- Needs improved hatchery incubator
- People in community taught how to manage finance for the project
