- Rally SA
- Rallying is a unique form of motor sport which can be done using almost any car provided the safety equipment is also used
- People can enter service pits to see what participants are doing
- No track; closed roads are used- work with councils and police for permission to use roads
- Liaison with local residents and community
- Racing against clock rather than side-by-side. 2 metre gap between cars
- Cars can be going over kilometres. Safety crews always within 5km from any part of course
- High tech devices used to enhance safety procedures
- Superspecial in Gawler on small location and did not attract people in the same way that Angaston did
- Rally SA started in 2001 by govt motor sports dept at Adelaide Show Grounds. First year successful but following year bad weather.
- Mt Crawford Forest not able to be fenced adequately
- Now run by private company which is different. Marketing mainly with posters in local area.
- Competitor numbers have gone down. Competitors pay entry fee
- Went to uni and studied Computer Systems Engineering but changed to marketing
- Kept interest in computers, websites etc
- Got this job marketing Rally SA. No budget. Using website and social media.
- Data for people receiving info was good but attendance extremely low. Looking for answers

- There will not be a Gawler Stage this year. Focus will be on forest and road stages.
- Every car has an in car camera. This is used for data collection.
- Funding is an issue
- Need to find interesting variations every couple of years to keep people interested.
- Contributes about \$2million to local economy
