### **RCGL Dues 2019/2020:** Stephen Arthur

- Last year, our dues were \$235 per member
- Direct costs will rise by at least \$8 per member
- Club expenses are divided into RI Dues, District Dues, RDU Subscription, Meeting costs and Club operations
- Income from meetings is dropping
- Not everyone attends all meetings so there is a growing disparity in contributions towards the running of the club
- Proposal before the Board:
  - Scrap weekly meeting fee
  - Continue to run the competition and sergeant's session as they do add to the enjoyment of the evening
  - Set the annual membership dues at \$350 per member to be paid as a lump sum, or by quarterly / monthly instalments
