Guest Speaker: Luke Walton—Animation

- Attending Flinders University
- Animation -2 different forms: 2D and 3D
- History— 1928 Mickey Mouse animation
- Used for movies alone or combined with film
- Stop motion eg Claymation Wallace and Gromit, Shaun the Sheep etc
- 3D used in 2 ways
- Boost existing footage
- Completely new
- Production is similar to live action movies but in virtual environment
- 3 steps modelling, rigging, animation
- Hierarchy of rigging (movement) demonstrated
- Animation— importance of movement fluidity
- 12 principles of animation
 - Squash and stretch
 - Anticipation
 - Squash and stretch
 - Staging
 - Straight ahead action and pose to pose – computer programs assist
 - Follow through and overlapping action
 - Slow in and slow out
 - Arc making gravity look right
 - Secondary action
 - Timing appropriate speed
 - Exaggeration helps to show how character is feeling
 - Solid drawing becoming less important due to use of computers but still relevant to understand
- Appeal characters need to be engaging
- Motion capture using actors with white dots on key points filmed and used to create animated figures eg Avatar
