- Exploitation of vulnerable people common problem
- Abuse, ridicule etc also a problem
- Lack of control
- Dependency

- Rejection, isolation & separation
- Devaluation
- 40% of crime against people with intellectual disability goes unreported
- 71% of crime against people with more severe intellectual disability goes unreported
- 48.2% experience violence 15% poverty, unemployment, homeless
- Choice and control need people to have knowledge, skills, training
- Principles and key activities of citizens advocates
- Free of obligation to employer. Support of person in need is the only role
- Person needing support here in Gawler; 40 year old, person to assist with reading mail, explain things etc.
- Police clearance organised, careful process of selection to match people, training in safety, orientation specific to the particular person, etc
- Training optional for advocates
- Includes sensory, mental health and intellectual disabilities
