President's Message: Dick Milner

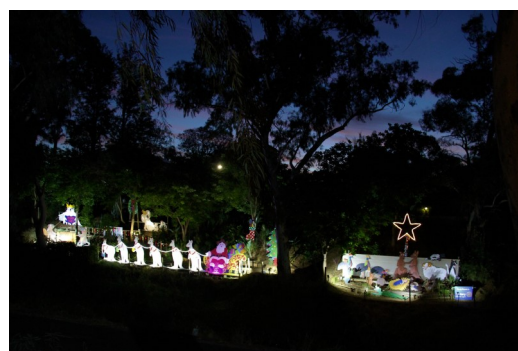
- As advised in my email of Sunday, the meeting on the 15 December 2020 will be a Christmas Dinner; please bring partners and friends

My Exchange Student Experience

- Left Australia in January 2020 bound for Germany
- Returned to Australia in April 2020 because of COVID19
- 3 exchange students came home and three remained overseas
- Experienced first ever day in the snow
- Attended a German school where there are no uniforms
- Had 2 classes of English
- Joined a roller skating club
- Visited Ludwigsburg and several castles
- Did a lot of walking in the Balck Forest
- Loved the architecture in Esslingen
- Visited a Mercedes Benz factory with a number of other exchange students in the district
- Enjoyed a Faschingsfest the German version of Mardi Gras or Carnival. This is the festive season before Lent originally celebrated by Roman Catholic and Eastern Orthodox cultures around the world—from Rio de Janeiro and New Orleans to the famous Carnavale in Venice, Italy that dates to the thirteenth century
- In spare time swam at the local swimming centre which also had water slides
- Cycled to school
- Met once with her host Rotary Club

- Host family took her to France for a weekend
- Had a day trip to Switzerland
- Visited the home of French sculptor Frédéric Auguste Bartholdi who designed the Statue of Liberty
- Dislocated knee on first day back in Germany
- Spent the last few days in Germany under COVID lock down
- Flew back to Australian and quarantined for 14 days in Melbourne
- Her Mother joined her in hotel quarantine over Easter
