
President's Message: Dick Milner

<u>Guest Speaker:</u> David Weatherley, Wheels In Motion



- Most Local ongoing programs in Rotary are generally aimed at fundraising: e.g. Art Shows, carousel at Semaphore, Plant Sales, car parking and even BBQ's
- Most occur annually
- Wheels in Motion is very different:
- It is not fund raising
- It is held every day
- It focusses on a real need in the community addressing youth issues
- Youth Unemployment in Gawler 2019 was 16.3% compared to an overall area unemployment rate of 4.5%
- Funding grant received 28 February 2018
- Car purchased obtained May 2018
- Initial Forum for potential Candidates and Mentors held July 2018
- Assessment of Participants and Mentors completed September 2018
- First Participants entered program October 2018
- Funding Agreement finalized June 2019
- Benefits
 - Recognition of Rotary's commitment to the community - Promotion of Brand
 - Addresses need of Youth in our area
 - Limited Involvement of Rotarians
 - No cost to Rotary Club Financially
 - Self funding at this time although struggling post COVID
 - Other Rotary Clubs are looking to commence similar programs
 - Prospect still investigating
 - Clare commences shortly?
- By September 2019, 17 people had completed the program
- By July 2020, 33 people had completed the program

Donations

- Wheels in Motion Gawler incorporated is now a Designated Gift Recipient i.e. registered by the ATO as a Charity and able to accept donations which are tax deductible.
- Anyone looking to donate can receive a tax benefit (similar to the Rotary Foundation)

Mentoring

- We are always on the look out for people to assist the Learner Drivers by volunteering time to sit alongside them

The Future

- Applying for any relevant grants to support ongoing costs.
- Most of the sponsors showcased on the car have given financial contribution.
- Rotary Club of Gawler Light to consider financial contribution to help maintain this important program and to help reduce costs for the participants
- We have incurred expenses even though the program was suspended including; Tyres \$440, Website \$400 and registration \$650. This reduced our balances while not receiving income i.e. the \$1500 balance was eroded.
