- In 2019 travelled to Norway and Sweden
- Had the privilege of hosting several exchange students from these countries so took the opportunity to visit them
- Stayed 2 days in Oslo then took the train to Lillehammer which hosted the 1994 Winter Olympics
- Voyaged on an Arctic Circle cargo ship up along the coast
- Saw the original Kon Tiki raft, a Viking boat, a Resistance Museum and an authentic ancient Norwegian village
- Enjoyed wine and shrimps with friendly people
- Went on a highlands tour
- Overawed by the amazing views
- Experienced the Geirangerfjiod which is 260 metres deep while the surrounding mountains are 1600-1700 metres high with waterfalls
- Went on the Aurland-Flam railwayand travelled on a fast ferry to Bergan which is the original capital of Norway,
- Drove in the Lærdal Tunnel which is the world's longest tunnel at 24.51kilometre-long (connecting the municipalities of Lærdal and Aurland in Vestland county, Norway, and located about 175–200 km northeast of Bergen
- Entertained during the Arctic Circle crossing ceremony with iced water down back of shirt
- Soon only battery powered ships will be allowed iin the fiords
- Impressed with the glaciers, sunsets and quaint villages
