Guest Speaker: Mark Young, Manager Adelaide Airport.

- Adelaide Airport is run by a public company which is owned by 5 superannuation companies
- Active sponsors of Royal Flying Doctors Service and mental health nurses in remote areas
- Before COVID19 turnover was about \$250m, 180 people were directly employed, 7000 people indirectly employed involving over 300 companies
- 9 direct destinations around the world linking to another 300 destinations
- Major expansion of the airport started 6 months ago—current situation has aided this work
- Situation is now dramatically different:
 - 50 international flights per weeks have decreased to occasional flights and adhoc private charters
 - 500 domestic flights have decreased to 30 to 40 per week
- There is one freighter per week from Singapore and one from Hong Kong which are being heavily subsidized by the Government
- Australians are now busily buying holiday houses in Australia rather than travelling overseas
- Retail at the Airport has been reduced to 2 to 3 shops opening a couple of hours each day
- The return of overseas student may be part of recovery
- Potential for trans Tasman travel
- Business travel is now less than 15%
