- Started interest in photography in 1965
- Posted to Malaysia which presented opportunity to buy cheap cameras
- Formed the Para Camera Club in 1972
- Club membership has averaged around 40
- Meets twice a month with the first night dedicated to competition and the second to guest speakers
- The Club is part of the SA Photographic Organisation which encompasses 32 clubs and focusses on education and the promotion of photography
- Club members run a number of courses including photoshop, audio visual, portraits, adobe
- Club used to meet weekly but irregular attendance led to twice monthly meetings
- Monthly competition comprises two sections; one with a set subject and the other covering any subject
- Standard level of camera worth around \$7500 with the lens about \$3000
- Challenge to encourage young people into the Club because of equipment costs
- Has acted as an Associate Judge since 1974 with focus on what is being depicted and the story behind by each photo
- Club annual fees \$40 which include \$15 for insurance
